ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION GUIDELINES

For Crisis Fund Payments

Distribution from the Reined Cow Horse Foundation(The Foundation) Crisis Fund is based on proven financial need arising from sudden and demonstrable hardship or disaster of a severe and unexpected nature or from serious physical illness.

Such distributions shall be limited to relief of the distressed with a real financial need. Before any distribution is approved by the Foundation Board, evidence of a proven financial need must exist and be submitted to the Board through the process outlined below for review and approval. Applicant must submit formal application to the Foundation.

By direction of the Board, the fund at all times will be maintained with no less than 50% of the donated funds remaining in the fund. To overcome the reluctance of applicants to send their federal income tax returns to the Foundation for evaluation of their financial need, the application will be forwarded to the Foundation Coordinator, who will eliminate the name from the application materials prior to submission to the Board for review. All applications for assistance will be presented to the Board for final approval. The Chairperson of the Crisis Fund will then notify the applicant of the Foundation's approval. It is recommended that applicants name not be shared among Board members in order to protect the privacy of the applicant, and to insure independence among the Board when reviewing the merits of any single application.

To be eligible for Crisis Fund assistance, an Applicant must be an NRCHA member in good standing for at least 2 consecutive years, and be recommended for assistance by a Foundation Director, NRCHA Board Member or NRCHA Member. It is recommended in evaluating evidence of financial need, consideration shall be given to the following criteria:

- a. Annual gross family income of the recipient.
- b. Annual net family income of the recipient.
- c. Number of children or other dependents comprising the family of the recipient.
- d. Availability of insurance.
