RULES AND GUIDELINES:

1. NRCHA rules apply.
2. Class will be held Thursday, February 3, 2011 following the World's Greatest Horseman Rein Work Preliminaries.
3. **Limited Division:** (Boxing class) Non Pro or Youth riders that have not gone down the fence more than three times.
4. **Open Division:** (Fence class) All Open, Non Pro, or Youth riders.
5. **Rein Work:** Rider can make up their own pattern. Rider must include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - One (1) circle in each direction
 - Two (2) lead changes in each direction (one right to left, one left to right)
 - Three (3) stops
 - Two (2) spins in each direction
 - Rein Work is limited to 3 ½ minutes
6. **Limited Cow Work:** Cow will be boxed for 50 seconds.
7. **Open Cow Work:** Time limit of 2 minutes and 30 seconds.
8. Any horse can be shown more than once, but with a different rider.
9. **Music:** Riders must have music during the run. Please bring a CD or iPod to the Media Office. It must be received by

NOON on Wednesday, February 2. Music must be verified by NRCHA Staff.

10. **Costume:** Riders MUST wear a costume. Must be within decency.
11. **Entry Fee:** \$50.00; 50% to Jackpot and 50% to donation for NRCHYA.
12. Winner in each division will be determined by high score. Payout will be determined by NRCHA payout schedule.
13. Best costume will receive special award.
