Practice Pen & Warm Up Arenas

A schedule will be posted at the show and pens will be run as Priority Work pens the same day the class shows. Additional practice works may be scheduled after the priority works for that set have completed. Practice pen fees will be billed to show tabs.

The arenas will have open riding time when classes have ended for the day. A schedule with exact times will be posted prior to the show. This is subject to change based on arena prep needed.



General Information

Veterinarian

Dr. Joe Carter is the Official Veterinarian of the NRCHA and will be onsite with his team from Oklahoma Equine. His team can be contacted by calling (405) 642-7845. He will be located in the Vet Room in Barn A.

Farrier

Scott Short will be the onsite farrier at the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes. He can be contacted by calling (208) 431-7405.

Health Documents

To comply with state animal health regulations, **ALL HORSES INCLUDING THOSE FROM NEVADA** will require a negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) dated within 6 months of the event, and a health certificate dated within 10 days. ALL horses, including non-compete horses, must have health documents during check in at the NRCHA Show Office.

Move In

Move in will begin March 22nd. South Point only allows move in from 8am-7pm. No exceptions.

Office Hours

The NRCHA office in Pilot Point, TX will remain open during normal business hours during the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes.

The office will be open on move in days from 8:00 AM to 6:00 PM. On show days, it will open one hour prior to the start of the show and close at 6:00 PM or at the end of the show.

Media Services

Photographer

Award photos may be taken in the arena by appointment with Primo Morales Photography. A contact phone number will be posted, or visit Primo's booth that is located on the concourse of the Main Arena. You are welcome to bring your awards as well as friends and family for group photos.

Videographer

Immediately following your run, you are able to view your run on the replay monitor at no charge. The monitor will be set up near the exit gate. Owners and riders may also visit the Equine Promotion's booth at any time to watch the run at no charge. If you wish to watch a run of a horse that you do not own or are not the rider of, there will be a charge to do so. The Equine Promotion's booth is located on the arena concourse. Exhibitors at the 2023 Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes will be emailed their videos at no cost courtesy of video sponsor Scooter Kat. The email listed on the entry form will receive the run video.

Media Policy

Visitors, spectators and exhibitors at NRCHA Premier Events are permitted to take photographs and record video for personal use only. Visitors, spectators and exhibitors are strictly prohibited from taking photographs and video for commercial distribution, including printed publications, web sites, social networking sites or similar media. This policy applies to, but not limited to, competition arenas; warm up arenas; barn and stall areas; and cattle facilities. Media representatives with NRCHA approved credentials are the only exception to this policy. The NRCHA Official Photographer Primo Morales, and the NRCHA Official Videographer Equine Promotion, are the only authorized outlets for competition photos or videos. The NRCHA will eject and/or indefinitely ban from its events anyone who provides, or intends to use, photo or video footage in violation of this policy. Stalls, Bedding & Feed

Stalls

The deadline to order stalls is March 6, 2023. A stall list will be posted on the NRCHA website approximately one week before move in. Please verify that your stall count is correct and contact the office with any changes. Cancelled stalls need to be verified by the NRCHA office for a refund. When you check in to the show office on arrival, notify the office of any cancelled stalls. You will be charged for any stalls you did not have the office verify. All stalls for the duration of the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes will be \$285. Youth stalls will be \$145. Youth stalls are open to youth riders that show in ONLY youth classes. If you haul in and do not need a stall, there is a day fee of \$25 per day, per horse.

Bedding

Three bags of bedding are included in the stall fee. Additional bedding must be purchased from the South Point Arena Feed Store. No outside bedding allowed.

To order additional shavings, you must order through the South Point Arena Feed Store using their online booking [link](#).

Stall Mats

4' x 6' mats can be rented from the facility. This provides 2 mats that cover the stall. If you wish to pre-order mats to expedite move-in, please order through the South Point Arena Feed Store using their online booking [link](#).

Show Rules



Animal Welfare

Payment Policy

All entries for the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes must be accompanied by a form of payment. Entries **WILL NOT BE PROCESSED** without a form of payment.

An open check or credit card will be required upon check-in at the Horse Show Office. In the event that no charges are incurred during the event, your check will be returned to you. Any practice pen charges will be added to your show tab.

All show tabs **MUST** be closed out at the horse show. Any NSF checks or credit cards will be charged a \$35 NSF fee. Any tabs that are not paid in full at the end of the show (including scratched entries) will be charged a \$50 late fee.

Payout Requirements

In order to receive your win checks from the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes, you must have a current W-9 on file with the NRCHA Office. W-9s will be emailed to the winners shortly after the class has ended. You will not be able to pick up your check without a current W-9 on file with the NRCHA.

Late Entries & Fees

Late entries will be accepted until noon the day before the class begins. Late fees will be charged to any entry received after the due date. Late fees are not charged to add classes or divisions to the original entry that was on time for that horse, **AND** before the draw.



Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes Derby

Terms & Conditions

The Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes is specifically for 4- and 5-year-old horses to be shown in a snaffle or hackamore. 6-year-old horses may be shown in a snaffle in the Non Pro Boxing Derby only. Horses may not switch headgear within the competition.

Horses must have been sired by an NRCHA Subscribed Stallion Program enrolled sire and be from a nominated foal crop year. A list of NRCHA Subscribed Stallions can be found on the NRCHA website: nrcha.com/subscribed-stallions.

The *NRCHA Rule Book* (NRCHA 10.4) contains the eligibility rules for NRCHA Limited Age Events and will be followed. Both current horse owner and rider must be current NRCHA members.

The Level 1 Open and the Novice Horse division may have a separate draw within the Open draw depending on the number of entries.

Open entries are automatically entered into Open divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Open, Limited Open). The tentative payout per division for the Open will be: O – 72%, IO – 22%, LO – 6% (NRCHA 10.5). This payout will be evaluated by the NRCHA Board of Directors at the event. 70% of entry fee will go to the payout.

Level 1 Open can be entered as its own class. Participants do NOT need to be entered in the Open, but may opt to enter the Open at a reduced fee Level 1 Open.

- Level 1 Open ONLY - \$600 entry fee – 70% of entry fee to payout
- Level 1 Open WITH OPEN - \$420 entry fee in addition to the Open entry fee – 100% of entry fee to payout

The Novice Horse class (\$12,500 earnings limit) will run concurrent with the Open division. Those entering the Novice Horse class do not need to enter the Open or Level 1, but may enter either/both.



Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes Derby

Non Pro entries are automatically entered into all Non Pro divisions for which they are eligible (Intermediate Non Pro and Limited Non Pro only). The tentative payout per division for the Non Pro will be: NP – 65%, INP – 25%, LNP – 10% (NRCHA 10.5). This payout will be evaluated by the NRCHA Board of Directors at the event. 70% of entry fee will go to the payout.

Level 1 Non Pro can be entered as its own class. Participants do NOT need to be entered in the Non Pro, but may opt to enter the Non Pro at a reduced fee.

- Level 1 Non Pro ONLY - \$600 entry fee – 70% of entry fee to payout
- Level 1 Non Pro WITH NON PRO - \$420 entry fee in addition to the NP entry fee – 100% of entry fee to payout

Non Pro Boxing entries have a single entry fee. 70% of entry fee will go to the payout. Non Pro Boxing entries are automatically entered into Non Pro Boxing divisions for which they are eligible (Level 1 Non Pro Boxing).

Select Non Pro and Select Non Pro Boxing is open to riders 55 years of age and over as of November 16th of the 2023 show year. The classes will be run concurrent in each of the Non Pro and Non Pro Boxing divisions. They will not count toward National Standings, and will be offered as jackpot only.

Chrome Cash will be offered in the Open, Non Pro and Non Pro Boxing divisions. Exhibitors must enter the main class in order to enter the Chrome Cash.

Refund Policy

The NRCHA Limited Age Event Refund Policy requires scratches to be made in writing and received in the NRCHA office.

- Scratches made on or before the due date will not be charged
- Scratches made after the due date but before the draw will be charged a 30% office retainage fee
- Scratches made after the draw will be charged all fees with the exception of the NRCHA fee(s) and video fee

Added Money

Total added money for the Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes is \$173,000.

Payout

The payouts for all divisions will follow NRCHA rule 10.5.1.

Terms & Conditions

The 2023 The Run For A Million Open Bridle Qualifier is open to all horses that are entered in the NRCHA Open Bridle at the 2023 Teton Ridge Stallion Stakes.

A rider may enter the qualifier more than once, however, they may only qualify once for The Run For A Million in Las Vegas, Nevada, in August.

The top 5 riders at The Run For A Million Qualifier will be invited to The Run For A Million in Las Vegas in August. Each rider can qualify only once, and does not need to show at The Run For A Million on the same horse they rode to qualify.

Rules for all NRCHA classes will follow the [2023 NRCHA Rule Book](#). The online version of the *NRCHA Rule Book* contains the most updated version of the rules.

The rein and cow work will be drawn on March 23, 2023.

Earnings from this event will count toward Lifetime Earnings and Limited Aged Event eligibilities where applicable. Earnings from these events will not count toward Merit Awards.

Ties

In the event of a tie for the 5th spot, high cow score will determine the winner. If the high cow score is tied, a cow work only run off will be held to determine the 5th spot.

Refund Policy

The NRCHA Horse Show Refund Policy requires scratches to be made in writing and received in the NRCHA office. Scratches made after the draw will be charged all fees with the exception of the NRCHA fee(s) and video fee.

Added Money

Total added money for the The Run For A Million Qualifier is \$5,000.

Payout

The Run For A Million Qualifier payout will follow rule 7.2.

The Spectacular herd work will be drawn on March 15, 2023. The rein and cow work for all Spectaculars and Horse Show classes will be drawn on March 23, 2023.

Refund Policy

The NRCHA Horse Show Refund Policy requires scratches to be made in writing and received in the NRCHA office.

- Scratches made on or before the due date will not be charged
- Scratches made after the due date but before the draw will be charged the office fee as a retainage
- Scratches made after the draw will be charged all fees with the exception of the NRCHA fee(s) and video fee

Added Money
