

NRCHA/MARATHON PARKING MAP:



SATURDAY, FEB. 22:

Before 4:00 am – Access as normal through Gate 42

After 4:00 am – Park in Yellow Lot A, access off Montgomery to Trail Drive to Gate 51, there will be NRCHA signage to guide you.

4:00 am - 7:30 am – Police escort across the road in order to walk into the facility, you will not be able to drive.

7:30 am - 8:30 am – **NO ACCESS AT ALL**

8:30 am - 9:00 am – Intermittent access through Gate 42 on foot.

9:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m. – **NO ACCESS AT ALL**

10:00 a.m. – Vehicles can get access to the property through Gate 29.

10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. – Intermittent access through Gate 42 on foot.

11:00 a.m. – Vehicles can get to the property through Gate 42.

SUNDAY, FEB. 23:

Before 4:00 a.m. – Access as normal through Gate 42.

After 4:00 a.m. – Park in Yellow Lot A, access off Montgomery, and drive to Trail Drive to Gate 51. NRCHA signage will guide you.

4:00 a.m. - 7:30 a.m. – Police will escort you across the road to walk into the facility; you will not be able to drive.

7:30 a.m.-NOON: NO ACCESS THROUGH GATE 42

8:00 a.m. – Vehicles can access the property through Gate 29.

NOON- 3:30 pm: Intermittent access through Gate 42 on foot.

3:30 pm: Vehicles can get access to the property through Gate 42

EMERGENCY PROTOCOL

LIVESTOCK:

In case of an equine emergency, Oklahoma Equine is available on site. If the horse needs to leave the facility, please contact Tina McCleary, Director of Shows.

Once instructed by show management, the trailer will exit the property through Gate 42, Gate 32 next to Casa Manana, or Gate 29 next to the red RV lot.

HUMAN:

In the event of a human emergency, show management or exhibitors will contact Tina McCleary, Director of Shows, to arrange for medical personnel to arrive. The Fort Worth City Marathon will have doctors located in the Amon G. Carter Exhibit Hall as well as an additional mobile medical unit.
