ENTRY DEADLINES & SHOW DATES

August 15, 2025 - Postmark Deadline for Final Futurity Payments:
<i>Miscellaneous fee which includes the stall fee, cattle charge, video fee and NRCHA fees.</i>
August 27, 2025 - Entries Open (Click for online entries at NRCHA CowHorse+)
September 2, 2025 - Slot Naming Deadline
<i>Slot entries must be named (horse and rider). A copy of the horse's registration papers must also be provided. Slot entries named after September 2 but before September 16 will be assessed a \$250 late fee.</i>
September 9, 2025 - In-Office Deadline for:
<i>All Horse Show entries and stalls are due in office.</i>
September 15, 2025 - NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® Slot Designation Deadline
<i>All slots must be designated as Open, Level 1 Open, Non Pro, Level 1 Non Pro or Non Pro Boxing. Slot transfers after September 15 will incur a \$500 slot transfer fee (\$250 prior to the 16th). NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® slots not named on or before September 15 will not be included in the draw. All entries must be paid in full to be included in the draw.</i>

GENERAL INFORMATION

Health Documents

To comply with state animal health regulations, **ALL HORSES INCLUDING THOSE FROM TEXAS** will require a negative Coggins (Equine Infectious Anemia) dated within 12 months of the event, and a health certificate dated within 10 days. **ALL** horses, including non-compete horses, are required to be checked in at the NRCHA Show Office.

Office Hours

The NRCHA office in Weatherford, Texas will remain open during normal business hours during the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity®. The NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® Show Office will handle all NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® business. The office will be open on move in days from 8 AM – 5 PM and on show days one hour prior to the start of the show until 6 PM or the end of the show, which ever comes first.

Due to the limited capacity at this year's finals NRCHA will not be offering complimentary Exhibitor Tickets this year. In its place NRCHA will be giving all entries two complementary drinks tickets which can be used during the Finals Party held on Saturday, October 18 in between the John Justin Arena and Watt Arena. Each back number will receive two drink tickets.

Photographer

Award photos may be taken in the arena by appointment with Primo Morales Photography. Visit Primo's booth that is located in Brown Lupton North. You are welcome to bring your awards as well as friends and family for group photos.

Videographer

Immediately following your run, you are able to view your run on the replay monitor at no charge. The monitor will be set up near the exit gate. Owners and riders may also visit the Equine Promotion's booth at any time to watch the run at no charge. If you wish to watch a run of a horse that you do not own or are not the rider of, there will be a charge to do so. Equine Promotion's booth is located in Brown Lupton North. Exhibitors at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® will be emailed their videos at no cost from Equine Promotion thanks to video sponsor, Scooter Kat. The email listed on the entry form will receive the digital file.

Media Policy

Visitors, spectators and exhibitors at NRCHA Premier Events are permitted to take photographs and record video for personal use only. Visitors, spectators and exhibitors are strictly prohibited from taking photographs and video for commercial distribution, including printed publications, web sites, social networking sites or similar media. This policy applies to, but not limited to, competition arenas; warm up arenas; barn and stall areas; and cattle facilities. Media representatives with NRCHA approved credentials are the only exception to this policy. The NRCHA Official Photographer Primo Morales, and the NRCHA Official Videographer Equine Promotion, are the only authorized outlets for competition photos or videos. The NRCHA will eject and/or indefinitely ban from its events anyone who provides, or intends to use, photo or video footage in violation of this policy. STALLS, BEDDING & FEED

Stalls

The deadline to order stalls is **September 9, 2025**. A stall list will be posted on the NRCHA website approximately one week before move in. Please verify that your stall count is correct and contact the office with any changes. Cancelled stalls need to be verified by the NRCHA office for a refund. When you check in to the show office on arrival, notify the office of any cancelled stalls. You will be charged for any stalls you did not have the office verify.

All stalls for the duration of the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® will be \$330 and will include four bags of bedding. Youth stalls will be \$185 and will include four bags of bedding. Youth stalls are open to youth riders that show in **ONLY** youth classes. Weekend stalls are \$150 for 2 nights only and will not include any bedding.

Bedding

Four bags of bedding are included in the stall fee. All other bedding must be purchased from the WRMC Shavings Office located in the Cattle Barn 4. **Outside bedding is not allowed.** You will need a separate payment for bedding once you get on the grounds.

Feed

Russell Feed will be on the grounds at the WRMC. They will be located in the Cattle Barn 4, next to the WRMC Shavings office.

Stall Mats

Haul In

If you haul in and do not need a stall, there is a day fee of \$25 per day, per horse.

RV Spaces

Spaces are available on a first come first serve basis and are handled by the Will Rogers Memorial Center. NRCHA is unable to reserve spaces. Full hook ups are available in the Red/VIP Lot, Yellow Lot and West of the Swine Barn. Spaces are \$70 per night, including water, electric and dumping station (50 and 30 amps available).

Dogs & Pets

No dogs or pets, other than ADA-approved service animals, will be allowed in the show arenas, or any part of the arenas, including the warm-up area, during NRCHA Premier Events.

In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and relevant Texas and other state statutes, service animals are permitted at NRCHA Premier Events. Service animals may not enter the stands of any show arena but are allowed only in the concourse areas of the show arenas. Pets, or dogs whose sole purpose is to provide comfort or emotional support, do not meet the ADA's definition of a service animal and are therefore not allowed in the arenas of NRCHA Premier Events.

SHOW RULES



Under the ADA, service animals are specifically trained dogs that assist individuals with disabilities by performing tasks or doing work. Examples of such tasks include guiding individuals who are blind, alerting those who are deaf, pulling wheelchairs, assisting during seizures, reminding individuals with mental illness to take medication, calming individuals with PTSD during anxiety attacks, or performing other specific duties. Texas law defines assistance animals as those specifically trained or equipped to aid a person with a disability.

A person with a service animal may be asked to remove the animal from the premises if: 1) the animal is out of control and the handler fails to take effective action to manage it; or 2) the animal is not housebroken. Any visitor who is required to remove their animal from the event grounds will still be able to participate in all NRCHA Premier Event offerings without the animal's presence.

Payment Policy

All entries for the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® must be accompanied by a form of payment. Entries **WILL NOT BE PROCESSED** without a form of payment. An open check or credit card will be required at check-in, in the Horse Show Office. In the event that no charges are incurred during the event, your check will be returned to you. Any practice pen charges will be added to your show tab.

All show tabs MUST be closed out at the horse show. Show office reserves the right to close your tab via the payment method on file at end of business the day you are done showing. Should your account be closed out using the card on file and you wish to change payment to a check, credit card fees will not be returned. Current credit card fees are 3.5% for US funds and 4.2% for Canadian or international transactions. Any NSF checks or credit cards will be charged a \$35 NSF fee. Any tabs that are not paid in full at the end of the show (including scratched entries) will be charged a \$50 late fee.

Payout Requirements

In order to receive your win checks from the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity®, you must have a current W-9 on file with the NRCHA Office. W-9's can be filled out in the Horse Show Office shortly after the class has ended. You will not be able to pick up your check without a current W-9 on file with the NRCHA.

Late Entries & Fees

Late entries will be accepted until noon the day before the class begins. Late fees will be charged to any entry received after the entry deadline. Late fees are not charged to add classes or divisions to the original entry that was on time for that horse, AND before the draw. After the draw, a late fee will be charged for any entry that is given a late draw position.



HORSE SHOW CLASS INFORMATION

Terms & Conditions

The NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® Horse Show classes are open to all horses.

Rules for all NRCHA classes will follow the 2025 NRCHA Rule Book. The online version of the NRCHA Rule Book contains the most updated version of the rules.

The Open Bridle and the Open Hackamore will have a finals. The number of horses taken to the finals is determined by the number of places that will be paid according to the payout schedule in section 7.2 and based on the number of horses shown in the preliminaries.

The rein and cow work for all Horse Show classes will be drawn on October 4, 2025.

Triple Crown Fee

The NRCHA Triple Crown is awarded to a competitor that wins the Open Bridle, Open Hackamore and Open Futurity at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® all in the same year. The jackpot will be progressive beginning in 2023. The 2025 jackpot is \$34,115 plus \$5 from each entry in the applicable classes added.

Refund Policy

The NRCHA Horse Show Refund Policy requires scratches to be made in writing and received in the NRCHA office. You can email scratches to entries@nrcha.com.

COWBOY CLASS INFORMATION

Terms & Conditions

The NRCHA Cowboy Class presented by 6666 Ranch held at the NRCHA Snaffle Bit Futurity® is open to cowboys who have earned less than \$15,000 in Open and Non Pro money at NRCHA events other than the Cowboy Class, and are currently employed by ranching/livestock operations. Exhibitors must indicate the name of the ranching/ livestock operation that they currently work for at the time of entry.

The Cowboy Class includes reined work, cow work, and modified steer stopping. Horses will be shown in the same age appropriate NRCHA legal equipment throughout all phases. No tie-downs will be permitted. Equipment will be checked after each go-round. A score of zero will be given for illegal equipment or bloody mouth on the horse. Scoring of the reined and cow portions of this contest will be in accordance with NRCHA rules. It will be at Show Management’s discretion if the reined and cow work are run back-to-back or separately. The modified steer stopping will be run separately from the reined and cow work and will utilize the Steer Stopping Judge Card. Modified steer stopping will be run as a walk-out roping and will not utilize a chute or barrier. NRCHA rules and regulations will apply in all other instances.

The rein, cow and steer stopping for the Cowboy Class will be drawn on October 13, 2025.
